Risks and Complications for Septoplasty and Turbinate ...

6 Change in appearance of nose or nasal deformity 7 Septal perforation (hole in septum) which may require surgery to repair 8 Drainage of brain spinal fluid from the nose 9 Failure to correct the nasal obstruction 10 Need for further surgery to correct nasal obstruction 11 Atrophic rhinitis or rhinitis sicca (dry and sometimes painful)
